



OHF Mandatory Team Official Course – Identity and Expression Course

Effective this season all team officials (coaches, assistant coaches, trainers and managers) will be required to complete the on-line course "Understanding Identity and Gender Expression and a Guide to the Dressing Room Policy and Confidentiality Statement". Completion of this course is a mandatory requirement in order to be approved on a roster for the 2017-2018 season. You will not be permitted on the ice without this being completed. Given that the course is mandatory, we (SDMHA) strongly urge team officials to complete this course now rather than waiting till September and finding out you can't be on the ice.

This mandatory course is being implemented by Ontario Hockey Federation of which OMHA is a member.



There are two modules and takes approximately 2 hours to complete. There is no fee for this course. Once completed, notification will be posted to one's member profile on the Hockey Canada Registry. You must complete both modules to receive a course completion notice.

In order to register for the course and complete the training you must have an eHockey account. If you do not currently have an eHockey account go to the following link:
